MS 226 holds keys to "Success"

Having been so well received, Ms. Renée was invited back to work with specific classes and is now facilitating a 10-session poetry-writing workshop series titled "Step/Write Into Your Greatness." The program focuses on life lessons, career-path choices and presentation skills, as well. It culminates on June 19th in a celebration of the students' writings printed in an anthology and the students being proud, published poets.
